**- Assistants:**

High school students wishing to work as assistants in the classes scheduled for younger children may apply directly with the Dance Supervisor, Anne-Marie Pilon-Gerdun

In addition to getting many volunteer hours needed to receive their High School diploma, they may qualify for scholarships and additional discounts on their dance fees.

**- Students registering for more than one class per week receive a discount on any additional classes.**

- \* **Students 9 yrs old and up are strongly encouraged to start attending 2 ballet classes per week.** This will allow them to increase their strength and understanding of technique and to acquire a more detailed and accurate performance.
- \* **Students who attend ballet twice a week** may also be considered for **Cecchetti Ballet Exams** depending on their level of ability. These exams are internationally recognized and provide a sense of purpose for the students with a clear focus on goal setting, technical ability and artistry. Passing the exam gives students a great sense of pride and added confidence.
- \* **Exams are held at the end of April** or at the beginning of May each year. An examiner from Cecchetti Canada is brought to Windsor, as well as a pianist from the National Ballet School of Canada, as the exams require live accompaniment.

\*Students who attend Ballet twice a week at a Grade Level (i.e. Grade 1-Grade 6) will also be eligible to attend **Master Classes at the National Ballet School in Toronto** once a year. This is an incredible experience and I would highly recommend it.

**- We are introducing “Combination Classes” this year for the younger students.** These are shorter classes meant to be taken in combination with other classes offered on the same day and provide a variety of dance genre for the children to explore. **Longer, more specialized classes are still at the core of what we offer** at the Académie as they allow students a chance to delve more deeply into the technique of each type of dance.



**- Ste- Cécile Dance Ensemble:**

- \* **Students wishing to register for the Ste-Cécile Dance Ensemble performing company must also be registered for a minimum of 2hrs of regular lessons including at least one ballet class.**
- \* **Students must attend all rehearsal on Fridays.**
- \* **Students will perform for a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 10 performances scheduled throughout the year. (More information to follow)**
- \* **The Ste-Cécile Dance Ensemble may have the opportunity to perform at 1 local competition as part of their dance experience.**

**Movement Improvement :**

The Movement Improvement classes are dance classes meant for individuals with special needs.

**Character Classes:**

Character is a sub-section of ballet technique that is based on folk dancing mostly from Russian and European origins. It is used on stage when the characters of a particular ballet story are meant to portray peasants or people of a specific region or nationality.

Students wishing to register for the Character classes must be registered for at least one ballet class per week.
